

Seeking – 3 set of verses

1. Desire

Psa. 42:1 As the hart pants / After the streams of water, / So my soul pants / For You, O God.

Psa. 42:2 My soul thirsts for God, / For the living God. / When will I come and appear / Before God?

Psa. 63:1b O God, .../ My soul thirsts for You, / My flesh faints in longing for You, / In a dry and weary land without water.

Psa. 73:25 Whom do I have in heaven but You? / And besides You there is nothing I desire on earth.

Psa. 84:2 My soul longs, indeed even faints, / For the courts of Jehovah; / My heart and my flesh cry out / To the living God.

Psa. 143:6 I spread out my hands to You; / My soul thirsts for You like a parched land. Selah

Isa. 55:1 Ho! Everyone who thirsts, come to the waters, / And you who have no money; / Come, buy and eat; / Yes, come, buy wine and milk / Without money and without price.

Isa. 41:17 When the poor and needy seek for water, and there is none, / And their tongue is dry from thirst, / I, Jehovah, will answer them; / As the God of Israel I will not forsake them.

Matt. 5:6 Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, for they shall be satisfied.

John 7:37 Now on the last day, the great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried out, saying, If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink.

Rev. 21:6 And He said to me, They have come to pass. I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End. I will give to him who thirsts from the spring of the water of life freely.

Rev. 22:17 And the Spirit and the bride say, Come! And let him who hears say, Come! And let him who is thirsty come; let him who wills take the water of life freely.

2. Seek

Deut. 4:29 And from there you will seek Jehovah your God, and you will find Him if you search for Him with all your heart and with all your soul.

Psa. 22:26 The lowly will eat and be satisfied; / Those who seek after Jehovah will praise Him— / May your hearts live forever!

Psa. 24:6 This is the generation of those who seek Him, / Those who seek Your face, even Jacob. Selah

Psa. 27:4 One thing I have asked from Jehovah; / That do I seek: / To dwell in the house of Jehovah / All the days of my life, / To behold the beauty of Jehovah, / And to inquire in His temple.

Psa. 27:8 When You say, Seek My face, / To You my heart says, Your face, O Jehovah, will I seek.

Psa. 32:6 Because of this let everyone who is faithful / Pray to You at a time when You may be found; / Surely when great waters overflow, / They will not reach him.

Psa. 63:1a O God, You are my God; I seek You diligently.

Psa. 105:4 Seek Jehovah and His strength; / Seek His face continually.

Psa. 119:2 Blessed are those who keep His testimonies, / Who seek Him with all their heart.

Eccl. 8:17 Then I saw every work of God, that man cannot find out the work that is done under the sun, because however man labors to seek it out, he will not find it out; and even if the wise man says that he will come to know it, he is not able to find it out.

Isa. 55:6 Seek Jehovah while He may be found; / Call upon Him while He is near.

Jer. 29:13 And you will seek Me and find Me if you search for Me with all your heart;

Matt. 7:7 Ask and it shall be given to you; seek and you shall find; knock and it shall be opened to you.

Matt. 7:8 For everyone who asks receives, and he who seeks finds, and to him who knocks it shall be opened.

Matt. 6:33 But seek first His kingdom and His righteousness, and all these things will be added to you.

Heb. 11:6 But without faith it is impossible to be well pleasing to Him, for he who comes forward to God must believe that He is and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

3. Pursue

S. S. 1:4a Draw me; we will run after you—

1 Cor. 9:24 Do you not know that those who run on a racecourse all run, but one receives the prize? Run in this way, that you may lay hold.

1 Cor. 9:26 I therefore run in this way, not as though without a clear aim; I box in this way, not as though beating the air;

Gal. 5:7 You were running well. Who hindered you that you would not believe and obey the truth?

Phil. 3:12 Not that I have already obtained or am already perfected, but I pursue, if even I may lay hold of that for which I also have been laid hold of by Christ Jesus.

Phil. 3:13 Brothers, I do not account of myself to have laid hold; but one thing I do: Forgetting the things which are behind and stretching forward to the things which are before,

Phil. 3:14 I pursue toward the goal for the prize to which God in Christ Jesus has called me upward.

Phil. 3:15 Let us therefore, as many as are full-grown, have this mind; and if in anything you are otherwise minded, this also God will reveal to you.

Phil. 3:16 Nevertheless whereunto we have attained, by the same rule let us walk.

1 Tim. 4:7 But the profane and old-womanish myths refuse, and exercise yourself unto godliness.

Heb. 12:1 Therefore let us also, having so great a cloud of witnesses surrounding us, put away every encumbrance and the sin which so easily entangles us and run with endurance the race which is set before us,
